Construction Update | March 20, 2020

Dear Neighbor:

As you may have noticed, the Mission Rock project team suspended construction work on parking Lot A in light of the Shelter in Place Order issued by the City on March 16, 2020 (Order of the Health Officer No. C19-07). Yesterday, the Governor of California issued a similar statewide order. Under these orders, Essential Activities including construction of public infrastructure and housing (particularly affordable housing) are exempt from the Shelter in Place requirements, and are encouraged to continue operations. Before resuming construction, the Mission Rock project team is working diligently to ensure social distancing practices are followed per the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health, and San Francisco Department of Public Health.

No earlier than Monday March 23rd, site preparation and pile driving will resume with a limited number of workers in the fenced area on parking Lot A. The pile driving program is scheduled to conclude before Friday, March 27th. We anticipate that site grading and demolition will continue throughout the spring as previously scheduled. Sound, vibration, and traffic experts will continue to work with the project team to monitor and mitigate sound, vibration, and traffic-related construction activities.
